

SPEAKERS AT THE ANNUAL CONFERENCE



Thomas Vestergård Pedersen, Danish Medicines Agency

Thomas Vestergaard Pedersen is a medicines inspector at DMA with responsible for inspection of pharmaceutical companies with regard to GMP and GDP. He has been at DMA for 3 years. Before that, he worked for 12 years as a manager/director at the Danish pharmaceutical company Statens Serum Institute. At Statens Serum Institute, he had responsibilities for biological API production, formulation and filling of vaccines and packing operation. All under EU GMP regulation. He holds a Ph. D degree in Exotoxicology and a Master in biology/chemistry from University of Southern Denmark.



Mette Rose Skaksen, Director, Confederation of Danish Industry

Mette is the Director of Danish Service Industries Federation and is furthermore head of The Healthcare Industry department and The Public Private department in Confederation of Danish Industry. Mette has worked in Confederation of Danish Industry since 2001. Since 2013, Mette has also been a Member of STARS* Advisory Board for the Minister of Health. Mette holds a Master of Economics. and a Ph.D. in economics from the University of Aarhus.



Sanna Gustavsson, Business Analyst, AstraZeneca

Sanna Gustavsson has worked for AstraZeneca in various roles since 2013. She is currently a Business Analyst in IT where she is focused on having the right IT systems and tools in place in our pharmaceutical manufacturing sites, to supply more medicines to more patients today and in the future. Sanna has a M.Sc. in Industrial Engineering and Management.



Johan Peter Bøtker

Johan started his postdoc work in 2013 with the Section of Pharmaceutical Technology and Engineering at University of Copenhagen. During his postdoc and PhD years he has focused on solid state analysis and continuous manufacturing of personalized medicine using manufacturing techniques such as hot-melt extrusion and 3D printing. During the years computer-aided design systems, finite element simulations and programming has been essential tools to both obtaining and analyzing the outcome.



Flemming Dahl, Senior VP, Novo Nordisk

Flemming Dahl is currently Senior Vice President and Head of Quality at Novo Nordisk, where he also serves as a member of the Senior Management Board and the global Quality management team. In his current role, he is responsible for the operation and development of the global Quality Management System (QMS), which covers all units in the company. Vision, mission and strategy work has been an increasingly larger part of Mr. Dahl's work, and in 2015 he launched a new vision and mission for quality at Novo Nordisk. He has been with Novo Nordisk since 1994 and held several leadership positions in the production area, including working nine years as Senior Vice President in biopharmaceutical production. Mr. Dahl is a member of the Global Pharmaceutical Manufacturing Leadership Forum (GPMLF) and was a keynote speaker at the ISPE 2016 Annual Meeting in Atlanta. Mr. Dahl is educated as a chemical engineer at the Danish Engineering Academy.



Jesper Hildebrandt Brix

Jesper became the director general of Médecins Sans Frontières in the beginning of 2016, but has worked within the organization before. Jesper is also external lecture at Copenhagen University, he is actual taking a master's degree of Public Health at London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine (LSHTM). University of London and gives lectures in security and safety in the field. Jesper has earlier been working with NN IT as manager of international HR and graduate program.



Andreas Hougaard Laustsen, PhD, DTU

Andreas was in 2014 elected to be "Denmark's Coolest Engineer". Andreas is specialized in antibody discovery and toxicov-enomics for rational development of antivenoms against snakebite. Andreas holds an M.Sc.Eng in Advanced and Applied Chemistry from the Technical University of Denmark and a PhD in Molecular and Cellular Pharmacology from the University of Copenhagen. Currently, he is a Postdoctoral Fellow at the Technical University of Denmark, where he is working on developing the world's first recombinant oligoclonal antivenom based on human antibodies against selected neurotoxins. Besides his academic life, Andreas is a co-founder of the biotech companies Biosyntia and VenomAb, and he is part of the startup team, Antag. Andreas has also been a driving force in the founding of the Danish entrepreneurship network REBBL5, and he writes the science blog, ToxBlog, for Denmark's leading science newspaper, Ingeniøren.
